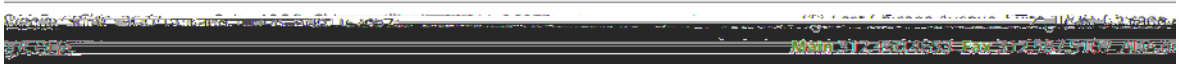

At its August 6, 2015 meeting, the Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) postponed action regarding the relocation to new building within the dental assisting and dental hygiene programs sponsored by the Phoenix College in Phoenix, Arizona, and requested supplemental information.
